

COMMERCIAL CIRCULAR-1ACE(R & C)/EE-C/DE-2/5;
DATE: 30-11-06**Sub:- Recovery of Pro-rata charges at the rate on per KVA from the consumers.**

The charges towards lines, transformer centers and service connection shall be recovered strictly as per provisions prescribed by GERC at Sr.no. 4 & 5 under Notification No.9 of 2005 and such cost shall be derived as per latest standard cost data in force from time to time. Such charges shall be recovered from all new as well as existing consumers/ beneficiaries demanding additional load on their contract demand excluding following categories:

- a) **Agricultural consumers** with the exception of Agricultural connection to be given under special schemes like "Tatkal Scheme" which may be brought out in future.
- b) **Water works and Sewerage Pumps** operated by/for any local authority other than Municipal Corporation.
- c) **Domestic consumers.**
- d) **Commercial consumers upto 100 KVA/125 HP** of contract demand.

Accordingly, the cost of transmission sub-station equipments is estimated as per annexure enclosed and the pro-rata charges are worked out on the basis of latest cost data/last purchase price as below:

Amount payable by the applicant = $K \times (P/Q)$

Where, P = Cost of sub-station transformer including switchgears such as isolator, L.A., breaker, structure, bus-bar, earthing etc.

Q = Rated capacity of sub-station transformer.

K = Contract load in KVA.

The average cost incurred for providing the facility connected to a sub-station on per KVA basis as per above formula is to be recovered from the beneficiaries. Considering the cost incurred towards augmentation of existing sub-stations and installation for switchgears, the amount payable by the applicant/beneficiary depending on the voltage class is as follows:

Sr. No.	Voltage class at which the beneficiary is embedded to GETCO	Per KVA/HP charges to be recovered in Rs.
1	11/22 KV	1770/-
2	66 KV	1115/-
3	132 KV	1090/-
4	220 KV	1070/-

The pro-rata charges shall be updated periodically from time to time and circulated accordingly for necessary recovery.

The pro-rata charges do not include the cost of lines. In case of application where there is a need to erect a new EHT line from the sub-station alongwith bay equipment or extend existing EHT line or strengthen existing EHT line for the applicant/beneficiary, an estimate shall be prepared for the applicant/beneficiary and its entire cost must be recovered from that applicant/beneficiary though the capacity of the line may be more than the consumer requirement.

Such charges shall be paid by consumer/beneficiary over and above the aforesaid charges.


At present, development charges are recovered @ Rs.900/- per KVA. Director (Technical) has issued circular no. GUVNL/Tech/667 dtd. 27-06-2006 and OSD/GUVNL/COM/ERC/531 dtd. 30-9-2006 to stop recovery of development charges with effect from 27th June, 2006. However, GETCO is charging development charges @ Rs.900/-per KVA from EHV consumers considering the augmentation to be carried out at the upstream sub-stations and augmentation of existing sub-stations.

All DISCOMs are requested to issue separate part of the estimate towards these pro-rata charges with specific guideline to each consumer/beneficiary to pay such part of the estimate at concern GETCO office under a separate account head. All DISCOMs are further requested to verify payment of the same before commencement of work/ release of connection and to follow it scrupulously.

The above charges shall remain effective from 27th June, 2006 and shall be adjusted against the development charges paid from the effective date. In case, any consumer is demanding refund of development charges paid during the period from 01-04-2005 to 26-06-2006, the amount so paid shall be adjusted against the above rates and settlement shall be made on the differential amount to be paid by the consumer.

These charges will further discontinue levy of development charges as per circular no. GUVNL/Tech/667 dtd. 27-06-2006. The amount so recovered will be deposited under a account head **55.507** "Contribution towards cost of capital assets from DISCOMs/ Beneficiaries on pro-rata basis (Non-refundable)" and may be operated for booking such receipts. The amount in this Account Head 55.507 shall be deducted from the capital expenditure incurred/ proposed to be incurred during the financial year. The recovery of pro-rata charges is in line with GERC with an opinion to recover the same from the beneficiaries.

All the field offices are, therefore, requested to make note of the charges to be recovered and implement the same accordingly. It is requested to submit a monthly statement of the amount so recovered from 1-1-2007 to Corporate Office, GETCO duly audited for all the estimates issued and paid within your circle.

Sub:- Recovery of Pro-rata charges at the rate on per KVA from the consumers/beneficiaries.

In continuation to the letter at reference (2) and decision taken by the competent authority, it is decided to recover Pro-rata charges on revised rates from all new as well as existing consumers/ beneficiaries demanding additional load on their contract demand as below:

1	Power Supply from 400/220KV and 220 KV GETCO sub-station	220 KV	815
2	Power Supply from 220/132KV and 132 KV GETCO sub-station	132 KV	825
3	Power Supply from 132/66KV and 66 KV GETCO sub-station	66 KV	835
4	Power Supply from 66/22/11KV GETCO sub-station	11 / 22 KV	850


The pro-rata charges shall be updated periodically from time to time as per latest standard cost data in force and circulated accordingly for necessary recovery.

As mentioned in GETCO's Commercial Circular no. 1, the methodology adopted to recover the pro-rata charges and exemption to only the categories as per provisions prescribed by GERC at Sr.no. 4 & 5 under Notification No.9 of 2005 remains unchanged.

The date of implementation to recover pro-rata charges shall remain unaltered as mentioned in GETCO's Commercial Circular no. 1 with adjustment of recovery or refund, if any.

Except revision in the rates applicable to different voltage class as mentioned above, all other procedure for recovering the pro-rata charges and its deposition in prescribed account head shall remain as mentioned in GETCO's Commercial Circular no.1.

All the field offices are, therefore, requested to make note of the revised charges to be recovered and implement the same accordingly.
