Sub: Approval of Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR) and Determination of Tariff effective from date 1ST April 2011.

The Gujarat Electricity Regulatory Commission (GERC) vide it's order dtd. 31st March 2011, has approved the ARR and determined the Transmission Tariff for the year 2011-12.

I. Transmission Charges

II. Reactive Energy Charges

Applicable to wind Energy Generators and CPPs who are also consumers and not to IPPs which are generating companies.

Particulars	Approved
For drawl of reactive energy at 10% or less of the net active energy exported	10 Paise / Kvarh
For drawl of reactive energy of more than 10% of the net active energy exported.	25 Paise / Kvarh

III. O&M charge for dedicated users of transmission line:

O & M charges shall be recovered as per Order No.3 of 2007.

IV Charges for Open Access

(IV.I) Transmission Charges

The transmission charges payable as given below are applicable for the use of transmission lines (system) of GETCO, the transmission licensee, by Generating companies, Distribution

licensee, other licensees and also consumers who are permitted open access under section 42 (2) of the Electricity Act 2003.

(i) The transmission charges payable in cash by long term open access and short term open access users shall be

- Long-Term Open Access users = Rs. 2775.06/Mw/Day
- Medium Term Open Access = Rs. 2775.06/Mw/Day
- Short-Term Open Access users = Rs. 693.75/Mw/Day
(1/4 x long term rate=1/4x2775.06=Rs. 693.75)

The transmission charges for short term open access users shall further be based on:

- (ii) Up to 6 hours in day in one block-(1/4xshort-term rate(1/4x693.75)= Rs. 173.4/MW
- (iii) More than 6 hours up to 12 hours in one block(1/2xshort-term(1/2x693.75)=Rs.346.87/MW
- (iv) More than 12 hours up to 24 hours in one block is the short-term rate = Rs. 693.75/MW

The long and short-term open access is as defined in the Regulation of the Commission.

(IV.II).Wheeling charges and Cross subsidy surcharge;

The wheeling charges are applicable both in cash and kind for use of distribution system of a licensee by other licensees or generating companies or captive power plants or consumers permitted open access under section 42(2) of the Electricity Act, 2003 for the year 2011-12 and shall be applicable as per the relevant circular of DISCOM and approved by GERC for the year 2011-12.


NOTE

It is to clarify that, the Transmission Charges in case of Captive power plant (CPP) / Open Access including Wind Farm shall be leviable as per **IV.I** above, both in case (Rs. 2775.06/MW/Day) & kind (Losses-4.18%) if the recipient unit are connected at 66 KV & above. In case the recipient is connected below 66KV, the wheeling Charges as per **IV.II** both in cash & kind shall be leviable **IN ADDITION** to the Transmission Charges as per **IV (I)** above.

If any clarification is required, the matter with specific details may be referred to this department immediately on receipt of the circular so the clarification on the common queries, if necessary, could be given to all the field offices by a common circular.

The recovery of Transmission charges from purchaser/User of renewable energy shall be in accordance with Commission Order from time to time.

The transmission tariff rate as approved may be given wide publicity & shall be placed on the Notice Board.
